TOPIC: Threading the Diversity

- Draw / collect / Click the Photographs of different types of Natural Fibres and Fabrics(Clothes) which are made by these two types (Plant & Animal) of fibres in paired state (UP & Arunachal Pradesh). By visiting your locality/country side/ Paired states or by discussing with your parents/grand parents. Collect the photographs and write the process of 'Making thread/yarn' and the process of conversion of threads into a 'fabrics' with the help of different equipments like TAKLI/CHARKHA and Hand looms respectively. Also, write about the states/region and climatic conditions to produce these fibres.
- Make collages of different clothes (dresses) worn by the people across the country and what type of fabrics used to make clothes in paired states (UP & Arunachal Pradesh).
