

Here are rubrics on a 5-point scale for the Summer Break Assignment:

## I. Originality:

- 5 points: The work demonstrates exceptional originality, showcasing highly unique and innovative ideas or approaches.
- 4 points: The work shows a high level of originality, with several unique elements or ideas present.
- 3 points: The work is moderately original, incorporating some unique aspects but also relying on existing ideas or concepts.
- 2 points: The work lacks significant originality and mostly relies on existing ideas or concepts without introducing anything new.
- I point: The work lacks originality and shows no evidence of unique ideas or approaches.

## 2. Relevancy:

- 5 points: The work is highly relevant to the assignment's objectives, effectively addressing all key aspects and requirements.
- 4 points: The work is mostly relevant, addressing the main aspects and requirements of the assignment with minor omissions or areas for improvement.
- 3 points: The work is moderately relevant, covering some of the key aspects and requirements of the assignment but with noticeable gaps or inconsistencies.
- 2 points: The work is minimally relevant, addressing only a few of the key aspects and requirements of the assignment with significant omissions or inconsistencies.
- I point: The work is not relevant to the assignment's objectives, failing to address the key aspects and requirements.

# 3. Completeness:

- 5 points: The work is fully complete, encompassing all required elements and providing comprehensive coverage of the assignment's objectives.
- 4 points: The work is mostly complete, with only minor elements or details missing, but overall providing a thorough coverage of the assignment's objectives.

- 3 points: The work is partially complete, including some required elements, but with noticeable omissions or gaps in coverage.
- 2 points: The work is significantly incomplete, missing several required elements and failing to provide adequate coverage of the assignment's objectives.
- I point: The work is highly incomplete, lacking the majority of required elements and providing minimal coverage of the assignment's objectives.

### 4. Creativity:

- 5 points: The work demonstrates exceptional creativity, showcasing highly imaginative and innovative ideas, approaches, or solutions.
- 4 points: The work shows a high level of creativity, with several imaginative and innovative elements or ideas present.
- 3 points: The work is moderately creative, incorporating some imaginative and innovative aspects but also relying on conventional ideas or approaches.
- 2 points: The work lacks significant creativity and mostly relies on conventional ideas or approaches without introducing anything new or imaginative.
- I point: The work lacks creativity and shows no evidence of imaginative or innovative ideas or approaches.

#### 5. Overall Presentation:

- 5 points: The work is exceptionally well-presented, demonstrating a high level of professionalism, clarity, and attention to detail.
- 4 points: The work is well-presented, with clear organization, effective communication of ideas, and attention to most details.
- 3 points: The work is adequately presented, showing some organization and communication of ideas, but with noticeable areas for improvement in clarity or attention to detail.
- 2 points: The work is poorly presented, lacking organization, coherence, and effective communication of ideas, with significant deficiencies in clarity and attention to detail.
- I point: The work is very poorly presented, demonstrating little to no organization, coherence, or effective communication of ideas, with numerous deficiencies in clarity and attention to detail.
